May 27th: All 2nd and 3rd grade items may be picked up between 9:00am-2:00pm

May 28th: All Kindergarten and 1st grade and Ms. Neisler's Class items may be picked up between 9:00am-2:00pm.

All personal items will be bagged and tagged by staff then made available for curbside pickup. The following are the procedures for getting students items:

- * Please enter and pull up to the main school door. Please stay in your car. Please stay in a single car line. You will loop around to exit the school
- drive.
- * Please place a paper in your passenger side window stating your child's name, grade and classroom teacher's name. Please also state if you have items in the trunk for the school to take.
- * Please open your trunks and staff will place items in your trunk. Please place any return items in a bag in your truck for staff to get. Please remain in your cars at all times. We want to ensure a safe environment for both our staff and our families.
- * We will provide all staff involved with distribution proper PPE to ensure safety for both staff and families.
