



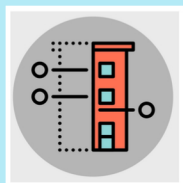
### What's the Plan?

In June 2018, the school board approved the next stage in planning to restructure the district's nine educational facilities. This four-year strategy will renovate and upgrade the district's aging and inequitable facilities such as non-climate controlled schools and technologically-challenged buildings. Most importantly, this restructuring ensures access to a common, successful educational experience for all K-5 students!



### STEP 1:

#### Reorganize Elementary Schools into Grade Learning Centers

### EXCITING BENEFITS OF THE PLAN

- \* Eliminates need for a waiting list at Coretta Scott King Magnet School
- \* District-wide equitable access to the successful IB Program for ALL students
- \* Boasts state-of-the-art, 21st Century facilities that emphasize technology
- \* Equalizes class size for each grade level to achieve equity
- \* Allows all students to receive equal time in Art, Music, PE & Library

### By the Numbers . . .

#### Estimated Cost to Repair/Maintain Current Facilities

*Life Safety Costs (\$10.1 mil) + Preventative Maintenance (\$39.3 mil) = \$49.4 million*

#### Estimated Cost to Repair/Maintain Current Facilities Over Next 20 Years

*Life Safety Costs (\$15 mil) + Preventative Maintenance (\$47.8 mil) = \$62.8 million*

**TOTAL COST: \$112.2 million**

**Cost of New Construction, Renovation & Upgrading = \$84.5 million**



### **What's the Plan?**

In June 2018, the school board approved the next stage in planning to restructure the athletic facilities at Crete-Monee High School. This second step to improve district facilities will renovate and upgrade the deteriorating stadium and fields, creating an awesome sports complex that will allow our students a state-of-the-art venue to practice and compete.

### **STEP 2:**

#### **Upgrade Outdoor Athletic Facilities at Crete-Monee High School**

- \* New stadium for football, soccer, and track & field
- \* New & renovated tennis courts
- \* New baseball field
- \* New Junior Varsity softball field
- \* New softball field
- \* Renovate current baseball field

### **BENEFITS OF NEW CONSTRUCTION!**

- \* Reduces operational costs
- \* Allows CMHS teams to practice and compete on-site
- \* Provides new, multiplex for community use
- \* Offers a multi-use stadium for soccer, track and field
- \* Creates softball fields for practice and competition



### **By the Numbers . . .**

**Estimated Cost: \$23.5 million**
