*Students are not permitted the use of a cellular telephone, video recording device, personal digital assistant (PDA), or other electronic devices, including but not limited to: the wearing of In-Ear Monitor (IEM)/Intra-Concha devices, behind-the-neck devices, over-the-ear devices, on-the-ear devices, wireless/cordless devices, clip-on devices, and devices used to sync by Bluetooth during student attendance days during those periods when classes are in session (start of school to the end of school) as this is a disruption the educational environment.

**The recording of others without permission, creating, sending, sharing, viewing, receiving, or possessing an indecent visual depiction of oneself or another person through a computer, electronic communication device, or cellular phone is in violation of the rights of others and is also not permitted in any manner.
